Burn in (testing)	A type of test where a computer, device or component is run overnight to identify any potential problems. It's used to identify failures that may occur within the first few hours of operation, ie: memory leaks, bad solder joints, or excessive heating
Hot Fix	A repair or (often software) upgrade of a working device. Hot fixes address critical and non-critical issues but must be applied as soon as they are released to prevent machine performance denigration due to unaddressed bugs or holes.
